Welcome to Tuscany

Montepulciano, with its Renaissance palaces and historic cellars, is a must-see for anyone visiting Tuscany. However, like many ancient villages, its historical center is protected by a Limited Traffic Zone (ZTL) monitored by unforgiving cameras.

A simple careless mistake can turn into a hefty fine (often delivered months after you return home).

At **Revirent24**, we know these roads like the back of our hands. We created this quick guide so you can enjoy the Vino Nobile and breathtaking views with complete peace of mind, leaving parking anxiety outside the city walls.

Beware of the GPS! The Gates You Need to Know

Our first golden rule: **don't trust your GPS blindly**. Often, navigation apps like Google Maps or built-in car systems look for the shortest route, guiding you straight into an active ZTL gate.

As you approach Montepulciano, keep your eyes peeled for electronic signs (if it says "ZTL ATTIVA" or there is a red light, DO NOT ENTER).

The main camera-monitored gates are:


- **Porta al Prato:** The main entrance in the lower part of the town (Piazza Savonarola).
- **Porta delle Farine:** Located along the eastern city walls.
- **Piazza San Donato / Via di Collazzi:** In the upper part of the village.
- **Via di San Donato:** Access to the Duomo and Piazza Grande area.

ZTL Schedules: When can you enter?

Camera activation times vary by season. Unless you have a special permit, transit for non-residents is strictly forbidden during these hours:

- 🌞 **High Season (May 1st - September 30th):** ZTL active **24/7**. The center is always closed to unauthorized traffic.
- 🍂 **Mid Season (April and October):** ZTL active only during the day, from **08:00 AM to 08:00 PM**.
- ❄️ **Low Season (November 1st - March 31st):** ZTL active during reduced hours, from **08:00 AM to 05:00 PM**.

(Please note: Schedules may vary slightly due to special events or holidays. Always check the local electronic signs).



Where to Park (Local Tips)

Montepulciano is surrounded by numbered parking lots (from P1 to P8). The golden rule is: park outside and enjoy the walk (uphill!). Here are our strategic tips:

1. The Smart Parking: P8 (Il Bersaglio)

- **Why choose it:** It's our top pick. Located just below the town center, you can find white lines (free parking!) and blue lines at very reasonable rates (around €1.50/hour).
- **The walk:** It takes about a 5-10 minute uphill walk to reach the center, but it saves your wallet and your stress levels.

2. The Convenient Parking: P1 (Piazzale Nenni)

- **Why choose it:** It's extremely close to the lower entrance of the town (Porta al Prato). Perfect if you don't want to walk too much or have mobility issues.
- **The downside:** It's paid parking and, given its convenience, fills up very quickly during the high season.

3. The Alternatives: P2, P3, P4, P5, P6, P7 They are arranged radially around the city walls. Follow the blue signs with the white "P". Always make sure to have some coins for the parking meters or download an app like EasyPark.

"My Hotel or B&B is inside the ZTL! What do I do?"

Don't panic, this is a very common situation. If you have booked accommodation located inside the ZTL, **you have the right to enter** for luggage loading and unloading.

Here is the correct procedure to avoid fines:

1. **Enter through the gate closest** to your accommodation (check with your hotel beforehand to see which gate to use).
2. **Drive to the hotel** and unload your luggage.
3. **IMMEDIATELY communicate your rental car's license plate** to the reception upon check-in.
4. The hotel will enter your license plate into the Municipal Police portal to register your transit and get you a temporary permit.
5. Afterward, you will still need to move the car to one of the external parking lots (P1-P8) for the rest of your stay.
